Applications are due by midnight **July 11, 2016** for consideration into the competition. Twenty-five businesses will be accepted into the competition based on the judging of applications. You can also drop off your application at the Fort Worth Business Assistance Center (BAC). **Late applications will not be accepted.** NOTE: No prior business plan needed to apply or compete.

Eligibility:

Applicants must fit the following eligibility criteria:

- Be a business with a DBA registered in Tarrant County
- Annual revenue of less than \$500,000

Prior clients of the BAC or our Guinn Complex partners, regardless of geographic location, that meet the eligibility criteria may also apply.

Ineligible applicants:

- Past Winners of the Competition
- City of Fort Worth Employees

If chosen as a participant in the competition, you will be asked to verify eligibility.



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Prize Packages:

Twenty-five participants will have the chance to compete for awards, cash prizes, and business services from sponsors, valued at more than \$50,000!
